mailmsg.CC = "whoever@kean.edu"  
mailmsg.Value("Reply-To") = Request.Form("email")  
mailmsg.Subject = "Whatever Subject You Want"  
mailmsg.From = "sender@turbo.kean.edu"  
mailmsg.Body = "Name:" & Request.Form("name") & Chr(13) & Chr(10)

All form elements in the HTML document must be named. Example: "Name" corresponds to the form element "name" which also corresponds to `Request.Form("name")` in the ASP page.

The last item in the body **NEVER** ends with `& Chr(13) & Chr(10) _`

The ASP code **MUST** go before everything else.
