2021–2022 Verification Worksheet for Independent Student

Your 2021-2022 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for a process called verification. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and your spouse, whose information was reported on the FAFSA, must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Office of Financial Aid. Note that we may request additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact the Office of Financial Aid as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.
