Guidelines for Forming an Assessment Committee

Assessment Committee Membership:

- <u>Chairperson (I.A.)</u>: The Chairperson of the candidate's department. In the situation where the department chairperson is the candidate, the most senior member or next most senior member of the department will chair that one Assessment Committee.
- Member (I.B.): A member of the faculty who is competent to review the scholarship of the candidate and to evaluate the candidate's currency and depth of knowledge in their discipline and specialty.
- Member (I.C.): A member of the faculty who is knowledgeable about good teaching practices and experiences in instructional assessment.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Tenured members of the faculty
- Full, associate, and assistant professors
- Members I.B. and I.C. above may be selected from outside the candidate's department, although it is expected that they would be chosen from within.

Selection

Members will be selected by the candidate <u>in consultation with</u> the chairperson of the Assessment Committee. The candidate must provide a statement of reasons for choices of members I.B. and I.C.
