Entry Requirements – All required to move from “Intended” to “Declared” Major

- A cumulative grade point average of **3.00** or better;
- A passing score on the **PRAXIS I** exam (Core Academic Skills for Educators). Register online with Educational Testing Service <<http://www.ets.org/praxis>>;
- Admission form signed by an EC Faculty Advisor
- A minimum grade of “B-” in COMM 1402: Speech Communication;
- A minimum grade of “B-” in ENG 1030: Composition;
- A minimum grade of “B-” in at least one college-level math course;
- A minimum grade of “C” in BIO 1000: Biology;
- Satisfactory completion (with a grade of “B-” or better) EC 2900 Clinical Experiences in EC Setting or, in the case of transfer students, an equivalent experience.

Students should apply for their substitute licensing after completing 60 credits. For more details contact HH 215
