- **Dec 2024:** Opt-in period to join a pitch team
- Jan 2025: EAB-led development session for pitch teams
- Feb 2025: Pitch drafting, facilitated by team leader; template pitch deck provided

### **Mid-Year Convocation**

- Mar 2025: Teams present pitches at Mid-Year Convocation
- TBD: Winning pitches announced; scoring from audience and panel of judges
- **TBD:** President's breakfast for winning pitch teams
- TBD: Implementation
