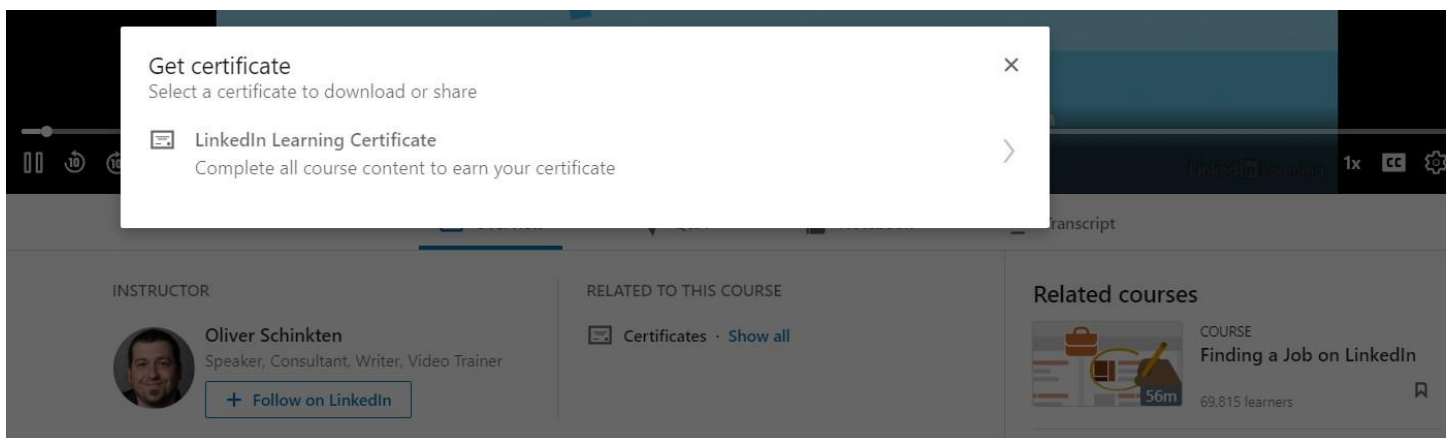


How to Utilize LinkedIn Learning to Increase Your Career Readiness

Directions are as follows:

- 1. Create a LinkedIn account.** If you need help creating your account, please see a member of [our Career Services team](#) or feel free to [use this LinkedIn Learning course as a guide](#). If you already have a LinkedIn account, you do not need to create another one in order to participate. - 3.
